

Interactive comment on "VHF antenna pattern characterization by the observation of meteor head echoes" by Toralf Renkwitz et al.

We like to thank referee #2 for the helpful suggestions and proposed corrections, which will be happily included.

- 1) We agree that a general figure of a typical meteor head echo event is missing. We will include a figure showing a typical distinct meteor head echo event (SNR vs. height and time) as well as its trajectory in x/y/z contrasting to a localized specular meteor echo and a corresponding description. However, a detailed analysis of derived parameters is certainly not within the scope of this calibration manuscript. Though, a brief description will be added.
- 2) We agree on that and has already been added.

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- 3) The referee is correct, MAARSY is certainly unique in the dataset of meteor head echo observations performed in the last years. This was a kind of polite understatement and is corrected.
- 4/5) The formulations have been corrected.
